As a PAC member you will be able to fish waters gained via privileged access events run by PAC members. You also have the chance to attend the annual Pike Anglers Club Convention. This is a major event, which attracts pike anglers from all over the country where there are presentations by some of the best known pike anglers from the UK and abroad, and the tackle trade is always well represented. There are competitions, and all manner of other attractions. It is the pike angling event of the year and is not to be missed, we hope to see you there.

The PAC holds privileged access/charity events on waters such as Keilder and Derwent reservoirs in Northumberland, Llandegfedd in Wales, The Lake of Menteith and Cobbinshaw Reservoir in Scotland Plus others such as Esthwaite Water, Wakefield Country Park and the River Wye.
